Teacher's Report May 2020- AGM

Wow ... what a start to 2020 for all of us, we have only just got our school running after the holidays and suddenly we were in a lockdown due to the nationwide Covid 19 pandemic. But even before this remarkable situation we held several meetings, where we tried to discuss the future of our club and consequently school. You would have all read the letter inviting you to this AGM, and I just realised that for me it will be the seventh one. I have been involved with the Czech Club and School here in Tauranga since late 2013 – as a part of the committee as well as the teacher – I have organised or helped organised numerous events for our community.
